Selection Criteria

The Leaders of Tomorrow Programme working in partnership with Southwark Youth Service, Secondary Schools, Black MBA USA, British Airways, Peckham Space etc., wishes to recruit young people from secondary schools, youth clubs and other specialist projects to join the Leadership Programme.

- ◆ Must attend a secondary school or youth provision in one of the London boroughs
- ◆ Age range 13-16
- ◆ Posses or have the potential to develop leadership qualities
- ◆ Willingness to learn or have an aptitude for business and entrepreneurship
- ◆ Willingness to help motivate others
- ◆ Willingness to undertake voluntary activities and work as part of a team
- ◆ Willingness to undertake challenging and unfamiliar tasks
- ◆ Must be flexible and adaptable
- ◆ Aptitude and commitment to undertake research work and write reports.
- ◆ Have an understanding of citizenship and volunteering
- ◆ Willingness to travel and posses a valid passport with more than six months before expiry beyond the date of travel
- ◆ Be available for evening and weekend activities
- ◆ Willingness to undertake fundraising initiatives
- ◆ Reliability and flexibility are key prerequisites
- ◆ Must posses or willing to develop good oral and written communication skills
- ◆ Must be able to network and give presentations to young people, community groups, policy makers etc.
- ◆ Must be able to develop at least one leadership initiative in your school/youth club or wider community to benefit others
- ◆ Commitment to participate in the programme for at least one year
- ◆ Should be well behaved, or demonstrate a willingness to change and be good ambassadors for LOT, Youth Service, Black MBA USA, British Airways, Peckham Space, participating schools and other funders.

If you think you possess some or most the above qualities, then please contact your teacher, youthworker, PA, or learning mentor for an application form. Whether you have been nominated or you have applied, final selection will be based on an interview and a short presentation telling us why you should be chosen and the contribution that you will make to the LOT programme.
